This project is based on a fictitious restaurant that prepares rib steak meats (beef,pork and poultry). Due to COVID-19 pandemic, a need arose for them to continue to prepare and deliver food to their various clients not only in person but also online.

The site was designed used **Dreamweaver**, which gave me the opportunity to work and display my **HTML, CSS, JavaScript** coding skills. The pages were not based on templates, but completely coded from scratch. To add to the user's experience I included some **animation** in the form of **gif files** (created using powerpoint) – quite an interesting experience, coupled with **behavior hover** responses of color, font manipulation, page navigation and **flex manipulation** which has providing a better site engagement and clarity – **fully responsive** design.

Currently, there is no database attached to the backend of the site (as this was not part of the project aim), however, it is something that I might include later on.

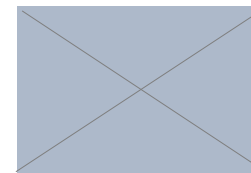
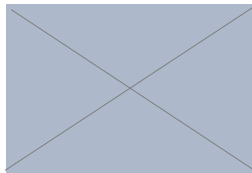

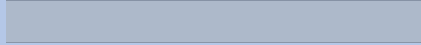
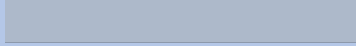
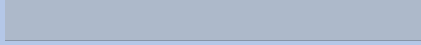
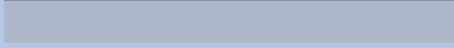
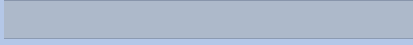
Project: Steak Shack - 'Take Out' Phase II
